The **Islamic Republic of Pakistan**, (the “**Borrower**”) has applied for a **credit** from the **International Development Association** towards the cost of **Sindh Barrages Improvement Project** and intends to apply part of the funds to cover eligible payments under the Contract for ***SBIP/G1: Building Works at Guddu Barrage, Kashmore and at Sukkur Barrage, Sukkur.***

2. The **Irrigation Department of the Government of Sindh** (the **Employer**), being the regional government department responsible for the regulation of flows in river Indus and associated canal systems with Sindh, invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the construction of about 33 houses and associated office, laboratory and social amenities at the Guddu Barrage Colony site, on the right bank of the River Indus at Guddu Barrage. The works also include construction of a new office building, construction of an annex building and rehabilitation of an existing house at the Sukkur Barrage Colony, Sukkur.

3. Bidding will be conducted through the National Competitive Bidding procedures as specified in the World Bank’s [Guidelines: Procurement of Goods, Works and Non-Consulting Services under IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers](#) dated January 2011 as revised July 2014 (“Procurement Guidelines”), and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the Procurement Guidelines. In addition, please refer to paragraphs 1.6 and 1.7 setting forth the World Bank’s policy on conflict of interest.

4. Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information from **the Project Management Office, Sindh Barrages Improvement Project** and inspect the bidding documents during office hours at the address given below.

5. A complete set of bidding documents in English may be purchased by interested eligible bidders upon the submission of a written application to the address below and upon payment of a nonrefundable fee of **PKR 25,000 or US\$ 300** payable through pay order in favour of **the Irrigation Department of the Government of Sindh**, for each set. The document has been posted at [www.sbip.org.pk](http://www.sbip.org.pk) and will be sent by surface mail.

6. Bids must be delivered to the address below on or before **16<sup>th</sup> December, 2015 at 1430 hours** Electronic bidding will not be permitted. Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be publicly opened in the presence of the bidders' designated representatives and anyone who chooses to attend at the address below on **16<sup>th</sup> December, 2015 at 1500 hours**

7. All bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security of not less than **2% of the Bid Price in Pakistan Rupees.**
